

This Cookie Policy explains how we use cookies and similar technologies on our website www.sustainib.co.uk ("Website"). Cookies will only be used after you have provided explicit consent, except for those strictly necessary for the operation of our Website. By using our Website, you agree to the use of cookies as described in this policy.

1. What Are Cookies

1.1. Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device (computer, tablet, smartphone) when you visit our Website. They are widely used to make websites work more efficiently and provide information to the owners of the site.

2. Types of Cookies We Use

2.1. Essential Cookies: These cookies are necessary for the basic functionality of our Website and enable you to navigate and use its features. They do not collect personal information.

2.2. Analytical/Performance Cookies: These cookies help us analyse how visitors use our Website. They allow us to count visits and sources of traffic, so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. The data collected is usually anonymous. These cookies will only be placed with your explicit consent.

2.3. Functionality Cookies: These cookies enable enhanced functionality and personalisation, such as remembering your preferences. They may be set by us or by third-party providers whose services we have added to our Website. Your explicit consent is required for these cookies.

2.4. Targeting/Advertising Cookies: These cookies track your browsing habits to deliver ads that are more relevant to you and your interests. They are usually placed by advertising networks with our permission. Explicit consent is required for these cookies.

2.5 The duration for which cookies remain on your device varies:

Session Cookies: These expire when you close your browser.

Persistent Cookies: These remain until they reach their expiration date or are manually deleted.

Details about cookie lifespans can be found in the cookie banner or settings.

3. How to Manage Cookies

3.1 Most web browsers allow you to control and manage cookies through their settings. You can usually find these settings in the "Options" or "Preferences" menu of your browser. Please note that blocking or deleting cookies may impact your experience on our Website and other websites.

4. Third-Party Cookies

4.1 We may also use third-party cookies on our Website, such as those from analytics services or advertisers. These cookies are subject to the respective privacy policies of these third parties.

5. Consent API Integration

5.1 Our Website uses a consent API to manage user preferences for cookies. This ensures compliance with regulations in the EEA, UK and Switzerland. For example, cookies related to services such as Microsoft Clarity and Google Analytics will only be placed after receiving your explicit consent.
